Reports were submitted by EDC Director Trinity Davis, PWD Joe Williams submitted his, and Officer Daniel Piper was present to present the Sheriff's Department report.

Commissioner Straw made the motion to retain a title company to assist with the property description correction on the deed without warranty to Noah and Miriam Landa. This was a gift deed from the Wheelers and a Quit Claim deed from Dub Ramsey.

Commissioner Straw made the motion to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance #2023-06-01, an ordinance adopting a budget for the fiscal year 2023-2024. Commissioner Miears made a second. Motion carried 4-0.

Commissioner Miears made the motion to adopt the proposed budget amounts for the 2023-24 fiscal year. Commissioner Ervin made a second. Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Perry read his recommendations for ordinance #335D. Commissioner Ramirez made the motion to approve these recommendations replacing ordinance 335D with 335E. Commissioner Straw made a second. Motion carried 4-0. The amended ordinance will be effective immediately.
