Mayor Perry led the opening prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and Texas Pledge and called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Commissioner Ramirez made the motion to approve the minutes of the previous meetings with a second from Commissioner Ervin. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Miears made the motion to approve the bills as presented with a second from Commissioner Ervin. Motion carried 3-0.

Item #5 Citizens Forum, Mary Jo reported that the food bank had a great hand out with a large food selection. Commissioner Miears also updated on the sign at the library.
