Commissioner Ramirez made the motion to approve this reading with a second from Commissioner Miears. Motion carried.

Kimberly Wallace was not present, no action was taken. EDC Director did make mention of this property in her report. This will be monitored.

Commissioner Miears made the motion to adopt the updated confidentiality policy for municipal judge office. Commissioner Ramirez made a second. Motion carried.

Commissioner Ramirez made the motion to assist the Youth Council with repairs at Peanut Park-Fenley Field. The City will pay up to \$200 on the current supplies needed. Any amount over that must be approved by Commissioners. Commissioner Miears made a second. Motion carried.
